## INTERPERSONAL COMMUNICATION CAN-DO STATEMENTS (for the full ACTFL guidelines, click <a href="here">here</a>):

**Important Note:** while these can-do statements are Interpersonal, the <u>Special Person Interview process</u> is about providing interesting input to students **on topics that matters to them**, not "practicing answering questions" or just eliciting answers from students.

#### **Novice Low**

- I can provide information by answering a few simple questions on very familiar topics, using <u>practiced or memorized words and phrases</u>, <u>with the help of gestures or visuals</u>.
- I can express basic preferences or feelings, using practiced or memorized words and phrases, with the help of gestures or visuals.

## **Novice Mid-High**

- (NM) I can provide information by answering a few simple questions on very familiar and everyday topics, using <u>a mixture of practiced</u> <u>or memorized words</u>, <u>phrases</u>, <u>and simple sentences</u>.
- (NH) I can provide information by asking and answering practiced and some original questions on familiar and everyday topics, <u>using</u> simple sentences most of the time.

### Intermediate Low-Mid

- (IL) I can provide information in conversations on familiar topics by creating simple sentences.
- (IM) I can exchange information in conversations on familiar topics, creating sentences and series of sentences.
